RESOLUTION APPROVING WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the voters of Presidio County authorized the establishment of the Presidio County Underground Water Conservation District for the purpose of protecting and preserving the underground water resources of Presidio County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code mandates that all underground water conservation districts adopt a Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Presidio County Underground Water Conservation District has prepared a Water Management Plan to carry out this purpose and to comply with the statutory mandate; and

WHEREAS, public comment on the plan was considered at a public hearing held on August 28, 2000, and notice of such public hearing was published two consecutive weeks in two newspapers of general circulation in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Water Management Plan was available for review in three separate locations within Presidio County; and

WHEREAS, the Water Management Plan was forwarded for review and comment to the International Boundary and Water Commission and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission Rio Grande Watermaster; and

WHEREAS, the Directors of the Presidio County Underground Water Conservation District hereby find that the adoption of the Water Management Plan accomplishes both its statutory mandate and its mandate from the citizens of Presidio County to protect and preserve the underground water resources within the county; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Water Management Plan was listed as a discussion and action item on a properly posted agenda of a public meeting of the Directors of the Presidio County Underground Water Conservation District held on October 16, 2000; and


