- a. The grant cycle begins September 1, 2012 and runs through August 31, 2013.
- b. Each potential applicant or grantee is responsible for designating an agency or department representative to attend and participate in the Planning Alliance quarterly meetings (El Paso County Planning Alliance/Far West Texas Planning Alliance), mandatory workshop(s) and other relevant meetings as assigned by the RGCOG staff. There must be an assigned representative from each fiscal agent seeking funding through the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division. In the event that the fiscal agent is seeking funding under multiple funding sources; the fiscal agent must designate a representative for each of the funding sources they intend to apply for.
- c. In the event that an applicant submits an application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, without having attended and participated in the Urban and Rural Planning Alliance meetings, mandatory workshop(s) and other required meetings as assigned by the RGCOG staff; the Committee:
 1. "Will deduct 1 (one) pt. from the applicant's total score for each missed Planning Alliance meeting; and
 2. "Will deduct 5 (five) pts. from the applicant's total score for missing the mandatory workshop(s).
